

JOEY FAUST, APOSTLE OF UNCERTAINTY

For such are **false apostles, deceitful workers**, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; **whose end shall be according to their works.** --2 Cor. 13-15

And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and **the dead were judged** out of those things which were written in the books, **according to their works.** And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and **death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire.** This is the **second death.** --Rev. 20:12-14

Heretic Joey Faust, the False Apostle of Uncertainty, has transformed himself into a minister of righteousness and legitimate Bible teacher. His end will be according to his works, and he should not mind such an analysis seeing that his system is based wholly on a system of works for millennial salvation to avoid hell fire and kingdom exclusion.

When we first came in contact with Joey Faust's prepublication book and subsequent E mail dialog, Faust had carnal Christians killed at the JSOC, which he connected with being hurt of the second death. He cited Rev. 2:11 to prove this and insisted that you must overcome (by works) to avoid such a fate. Now, it seems that Joey is uncertain about his previous his Overcomer's Cult teaching told us that the breath of God kills the believer at the JSOC, and it then becomes the lake of fire (which at one point he had in heaven). He now emphasizes the lake of fire/second death at the Great White Throne judgment for only the lost. Heretic Faust contends that the carnal Christian, after the millennial kingdom, gets out of a thousand years hell fire and assumes the eternal state in eternity.

Since Faust tells us that carnal believers are killed at the JSOC, they must be then considered DEAD. And the DEAD are judged at the Great White Throne according to their works (Faust cannot produce a proof text to prove that these dead Christians come alive again). If Faust says that the dead become alive after they are taken out of hell, he must say that both the saved and the lost both do so. Nevertheless, death and hell are then cast into the lake of fire, which is the second death, which only Faust's overcomers are promised to escape. Since Faust has these carnal believers both dead and in hell along with lost unbelievers, we must conclude that dead carnal believers as well as unbelievers are cast into the lake of fire. That is if Faust is correct! If Faust is not correct about Christians being killed at the JSOC spending 1000 years in hell fire, he is a False Apostle and a deceitful worker and must needs be marked so.

The Kingdom of Heaven, the Non-carnal, the Carnal, the Lost

Whosoever therefore shall *BREAK* one of these *LEAST COMMANDMENTS*, and shall teach men so, he shall be called *LEAST IN THE KINGDOM FOF HEAVEN*: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called *GREAT IN THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN*. For I say unto you, That except your *RIGHTEOUSNESS SHALL EXCEED* the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall *IN NO CASE ENTER INTO THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN.* --Matthew 5:19, 20

Joey Faust attempts through the power of suggestion, misplaced proof text, misinterpreted proof texts, innuendo, erroneously linked proof texts, inference, pontification, and pat answers to advance his cause of making a distinction between the carnal and the non carnal and is still unable to do it. Here is a passage that makes a distinction between two groups of believers and the lost. Both groups of Christians end up in the kingdom of heaven, the one in the position of greatness and the other in the position of least. The lost are denied entrance into the kingdom of heaven, because they only have their own righteousness, which is not sufficient righteousness, even that righteousness of the Lord Jesus Christ, which is obtained by believing. By teaching the heresy that he does, Joey Faust, if he makes it to the kingdom, will no doubt end up as the least in that kingdom. So, it can be seen here that the differentiation amongst Christians is position rather than entrance versus any exclusion.

Rewardable Trial by FIRE and the Apostle of Uncertainty

That the *TRIAL* of your faith *IS PRECIOUS*, being much more precious than *GOLD* that persisheth, though it *BE TRIED WITH FIRE*, might be found *UNTO PRAISE* and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ. --1 Peter 1:7

Yet if a man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf. For the time is come that *JUDGMENT* must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God. And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and sinner appear? -- 1 Peter 4:16-18

Joey Faust, spiritual arsonist, apostle of uncertainty, sees a fire in everything; he has never met a fire that he does not like. It is time for Joey to learn something about Fiery Fires and judgment that do not involve carnality or sin or punishment. What we have here is *FIERY JUDGMENT* that has nothing to do with carnality or sin or punishment of the believer. Only two camps here--the lost and the righteous. No distinctions are made between the carnal and the non carnal. These are righteous folks going through a *FIERY TRIAL*. The comparison is to earthly *GOLD* that is *TRIED* by *FIRE*. No burned up Christian here, only Christians going through a Fire. This trial is much more *PRECIOUS* than earthly Gold and will be rewarded at the appearing of the Lord at the *JSOC* with praise and honor and glory and heavenly *GOLD*.

This *FIERY* trial is called a judgment of the righteous, which begins with them--not the carnal, and is rewarded accordingly. Even the righteous are said to be scarcely saved. It is too bad that Joey Faust cannot use these fiery, judgment passages to get you into the lake of fire and hell, dear reader. Now, Joey Faust's *RULE* is that if it can happen on earth, it can happen at the *JSOC*. 'Nuff said! Thank you Jesus!

Is Continuous Eternal Life Conditional upon Forsaking Things?

And *EVERYONE* that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my name's sake, shall receive an hundred fold, and *SHALL INHERIT ETERNAL LIFE*.
– Matthew 19:29

Since Joey Faust loves to adapt certain instructions and promises in the word of God to conditions for continuous eternal life, we thought it appropriate for Joey to adapt just one more conditional passage (above) to his scheme, which surely will insure his getting killed at the *JSOC* and his trip to the lake of fire and hell.
