

Kingdom Inheritance, Entrance, Exclusion, Lake of Fire versus Joey Faust

“The danger for unfaithful believers is seen to be only a loss of *crowns*. However, the Scripture teaches that *all* Christians who *enter* the kingdom from this dispensation are glorified *kings*. To lose the *crown* is to lose kingdom *entrance* (Revelation 5:10, 20:4-6, 1 Corinthians 9:24-27). All Christians, which enter the kingdom, enter *crowned*. Faithful Christians will primarily reign over nations who will then populate the earth.” -- Joey Faust, *The Rod: Will God Spare It?* - p. 82, 83 (Also p. 144 - pre pub book)

Rom 5:8, 9 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. **MUCH MORE THEN**, being now justified by his blood, we **shall be saved from WRATH through him**.

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *him*, that we may be also glorified together.

Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. And such **WERE** some of you: **BUT YE ARE WASHED**, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. --1 Cor. 6:10, 11

1 Cor 6:9 – 11 [9.] Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, [10.] Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. [11.] **And such were some of you:** but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, **but ye are justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

1 Cor 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and **blood CANNOT INHERIT the kingdom of God;**

And **IF YE BE CHRIST’S**, then are ye Abraham’s seed, and **HEIRS** according to the promise . . . **thou art no more a servant, BUT A SON; and if a son, then an HEIR of God through Christ.** -- Gal. 3:29, 4:17

Eph 1:13, 14 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were **sealed with that holy Spirit of promise**, Which is **the earnest of our INHERITANCE UNTIL** the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

Eph 5:3 - 7 [3.] But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; [4.] Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks. [5.] For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. [6.] Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. [7.] Be not ye therefore partakers with them. Col 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath **translated us into the KINGDOM of his dear Son:**

Wherefore **WE RECEIVING A KINGDOM** which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. -- Heb. 12:28

1Th 1:10 And to wait for his Son from heaven . . . Jesus, which **delivered us from THE WRATH TO COME.**

2 Thess 2:12 That ye would **walk worthy of God**, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.

1Th 5:9, 10 For God hath not appointed us **TO WRATH**, but **TO OBTAIN SALVATION** by our **Lord Jesus Christ** . . . Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should **live together with him**. Wherefore **comfort** yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.

And the Lord shall **DELIVER ME** from **EVERY EVIL** work, and will **PRESERVE ME unto his HEAVENLY KINGDOM** . . . -- 2 Tim. 4:18

1Pe 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a **royal priesthood**, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Hebrew 13:5 . . . I will **NEVER** leave thee nor forsake thee . . .
